WHEREAS the State Government, in recognition of the contribution of journalists towards society, has been considering a scheme to provide financial support, in the form of a monthly pension, to aged journalists facing acute financial hardship;

NOW, after careful consideration of all aspects of the matter, the Governor is pleased to introduce the following pension scheme for journalists:

West Bengal Pension Scheme for Journalists, 2018

1. Short title and commencement: –

- (a) The Scheme shall be called the “West Bengal Pension Scheme for Journalists, 2018”;
- (b) It shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 2018.

2. Definition – In this Scheme, unless the context otherwise requires, -

- a) “Journalist” means journalists from Print and /or Electronic Media, Photo Journalists and will also include journalists working in Web Portals
- b) “Scheme” means “West Bengal Pension Scheme for the Journalists, 2018”
- c) “State Government” means the Information and Cultural Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal;
- d) “State” means the State of West Bengal.

3. Applicability of the Scheme - The Scheme shall be applicable to all the Journalists of the State who have attained at least 60 years of age and have retired from regular employment as a journalist / photo-journalist / correspondent / camera person (news) / journalists engaged in news production, on the date of his application and does not draw any pension from any other source (except under Employees Provident Fund and / or covered under any other personal pension scheme, for which he / she had made contribution personally) and does not receive any regular salary / emoluments from any organization.

4. **Rate of Pension**– A monthly pension of Rs. 2500/- (two thousand and five hundred only) shall be extended to the journalists eligible as per this Scheme but shall not, under any circumstances, be extended to the family members of the journalists concerned.
5. **Eligibility** – Eligibility criteria for being included in this Scheme shall be as follows:
- (a) Age of the applicant, on the date of application, shall be not less than 60 years.
 - (b) Applicant should have served as journalist in the State for not less than a period of ten years preceding his / her date of retirement.
 - (c) The applicant should have had accreditation from the Government of West Bengal for at least 10 years, to be counted covering the entire period of his / her accreditation, with or without break.
 - (d) In cases of non-accreditation, the applicant shall have to furnish relevant documents to prove his eminence in the field of journalism and should have completed at least 15 years in the profession of journalism.
 - (e) The applicant should not be engaged in a regular employment and should not draw any pension from any other source (except under Employees Provident Fund and / or any other personal pension scheme, for which he / she had made contribution personally) and does not receive a regular salary / monthly emoluments from any organization.
6. **Enrolment:** –
- (a) For availing the benefits of this Scheme, journalists found eligible under clause (5) of this Scheme are to be enrolled, and the enrolment shall be taken up for renewal annually at the end of each financial year.
 - (b) For enrolment, duly-filled in application shall have to be submitted in the prescribed format, as per Annexure-I of the Scheme, to the Principal Secretary, Information and Cultural Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal along with following documents:
 - (i) Documents of age proof where the date of birth is mentioned.
 - (ii) Certificate from a Group-A Government Officer in support of the monthly income specifying the amount and non-employment certificate,
 - (iii) Supporting documents on details of the Bank Account, where the applicant intends to receive the benefits, as per information provided in the Application Form,
 - (iv) Two copies of signed passport size photographs of the applicant,
 - (v) Photocopy of the Press Accreditation card, issued to the applicant by the Government of West Bengal, if applicable as per clause 5 of this Scheme,
 - (vi) A declaration in the form of Affidavit to the effect regarding sub-clause (b), (c) and (e) of Clause 5, in the format “Annexure II-A & II-B” of the Scheme,
 - (vii) For annual renewal, the applicant shall have to submit within March of every year, a certificate from a Group-A Government Officer in support of the monthly income and non-employment certificate along with Life Certificate to be issued by a Group A Government Officer in the standard format, to be specified subsequently.
 - (viii) Any other document that the Government may deem relevant and may ask for, in writing.

(c) The selection and annual renewal of journalists found eligible / suitable will be done through a "State Level Screening Committee" to be constituted for this purpose by the State Government. The committee will recommend applications to the State Government for enrolment and renewal, as the case may be.

7. Mode of Payment – (1) Monthly Pension under this Scheme will be released to the bank account of the beneficiary through RTGS (Real Time Gross Settlement) / NEFT (National Electronic Fund Transfer) mode.

The Scheme will be implemented by the Information and Cultural Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal.

The charges will be met out of the budgetary provision of the Information and Cultural Affairs Department under Demand no. 30 under the Head of Account

"30-2235-60-102-NP-005-04-00-Pension/Gratuities-V".
