

## ORDER

**No. 90/RPT**

**Date: 09/06/2022**

WHEREAS, it has been observed that several instances of two wheeler riders riding without helmet as well as carrying pillion riders without helmet have been reported and occurrences of such infringement of rules have increased manifold. In spite of several prosecutions in such cases being drawn up by the law enforcement agency, the apprehension and possibility of untoward incidents/ accidents arising out of riding two wheelers without helmet always remains. In order to ensure better road discipline and deter such violators of traffic laws, stringent actions need to be taken in accordance with law;

AND

WHEREAS, it is necessary that some checks should be put on such violators in the larger interest of safety of the citizens, immediate and stringent action need to be taken in accordance with law to have greater deterrence and for prevention of the same;

AND

WHEREAS, Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act. 2 of 1974) empowers an Executive Magistrate to issue order in respect of cases of apprehended danger;

Now, therefore, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under **Notification No. 2104-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II)** dated 31.12.2021 read with the **Notification No. 2102-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II)** dated 31.12.2021 and the **Notification No. 2105-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II)** dated 31.12.2021 read with the **Notification No. 2103-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II)** dated 31.12.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974); do hereby order that a rule of **NO HELMET NO PETROL** shall be enforced within the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police to the effect that **no petrol pump within the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police shall henceforth sell petrol to any such two wheeler rider who arrives at the petrol pump riding a two wheeler without wearing helmet as well as carries pillion rider without helmet in contravention of the provisions as enumerated under sections 128, Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and 129, Motor Vehicles Act 1988 read with section 177, Motor Vehicles Act 1988.**

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub-section (2) of section 144 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973. It shall be published for information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on Notice Boards of the offices of the all Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic Department, Kolkata, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic (South), Kolkata, all the Police Stations and the Traffic Guards concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

This order shall come into force with effect from **14.06.2022** and shall be in effect for a period of **60(sixty) days** i.e. till **12.08.2022** or until further order.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under extant applicable laws.

WHEREAS, mass petitions have been received by this office from students and scholars of several educational institutions housed in and around College Street area, requesting for not allowing any rallies, processions, meetings, demonstrations therein as the use of loudspeakers and sloganeering causes major disturbance to the ongoing classes and other academic activities;

AND

WHEREAS, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the **Notification No. 2104- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 read with the Notification No. 2102-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 and the Notification No. 2105-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 read with the Notification No. 2103-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021** to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion that there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for not allowing any rallies/meetings/processions/demonstrations originating from/terminating in and around College Square in the academic interest of large number of students within the said areas as mentioned in the following schedule in the town of Kolkata, so as to ensure immediate prevention and speedy remedy;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section(1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure,1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub-Section(3) of the said Section, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction), do hereby prohibit for a period of **60 (Sixty) days from 14.06.2022 to 12.08.2022 except Sundays** or until further order, any unlawful assembly of 05(five) or more persons or processions or rallies or meetings or demonstrations or carrying of lathi, any lethal or other dangerous weapons or doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances of the public tranquillity and breach of the peace within the area as scheduled below in the Town of Kolkata.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C, 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of all Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

**SCHEDULE**

The area within the jurisdiction of Amherst Street PS, Muchipara PS and Jorasanko PS in the town of Kolkata bounded –

(1)	On the North by	M.G. Road from College Street Crossing to Shyamacharan Dey Street Crossing.
(2)	On the South by	Surya Sen Street from Colootola Street Crossing (Surya Sen Street and College Street Crossing) to Bankim Chatterjee Street Crossing.
(3)	On the East by	Entire Bankim Chatterjee Street, Shyamacharan Dey Street from Bankim Chatterjee Street Crossing to M.G. Road Crossing.
(4)	On the West by	College Street from M.G. Road crossing upto Medical College & Hospital (College St. and Surya Sen Street Crossing.).

**EXPLANATION** : In this order, the TOWN of KOLKATA means the town of Kolkata as defined in Section 3 of the Calcutta Police Act, 1866 (Bengal Act IV of 1866).

## ORDER

WHEREAS, a large number of commercial places/ shops have come up in Kolkata which are popularly known as Cyber Café and a large number of people visit those to use the facilities available in such places including Internet access and E-mail facility;

AND

WHEREAS, there is reasonable apprehension that Criminals / Antisocial / Antinational elements may use these facilities to mislead the security/ investigating agencies, create panic in the public, endanger the security of VVIPs and Government Institutions, help in the anti-national activities thus directly affecting the security of the State;

AND

WHEREAS, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the **Notification No. 2104- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 read with the Notification No. 2102-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 and the Notification No. 2105-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021 read with the Notification No. 2103-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 31.12.2021** to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion that it is necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life or safety, to thwart/ prevent terrorist activities which may affect the security of the state and disturbance of public order and tranquility;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub Section (I) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub Section (3) of the said Section, I, **Vineet Kumar Goyal**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) do hereby order: -

- a) **Prohibiting the use of Cyber Café by a person whose identity has not been established by the owner of the Café.**
- b) **Maintaining a register to identify the visitor/user.**
- c) **Making an entry in the handwriting of the visitor/user mentioning name, address, telephone number and the details of identity proof. The visitor/user shall also sign the register kept for this purpose.**
- d) **Establishing identity of the visitor/user through Identity Card issued by Govt., Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC), Ration Card, Driving License, Passport and AADHAR Card (any one of them).**
- e) **Preserving activity server log in main server and its record should be preserved for at least six months.**
- f) **Informing any activity of suspicious nature of a visitor by the owner of Cyber Café to the local Police Station.**

And

- g) **Maintaining record about the specific computer used by the person.**

The above mentioned clauses are meant for strict compliance by the owners of such Cyber Cafes in the Metropolitan area of Kolkata and its Suburbs.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation;

This order shall come into force for a period of **60 (Sixty) days** with effect from **14.06.2022 to 12.08.2022** or until further order.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under the extant applicable laws.
