WHEREAS, vide an order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, in connection with the Writ Petition (Civil) No. 3727 of 1985 in the matter of M.C. Mehta - Petitioner - Vs - Union of India and others - Respondents, had been received to the effect that the tanneries do not function in the area under the jurisdiction of Tangra Police Station, Topsia Police Station, Karaya Police Station and Tiljala Police Station.

AND

WHEREAS, there is reasonable apprehension that some tanneries may resume functioning again by taking electricity and Corporation water illegally violating the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court;

Now, therefore, I, Soumen Mitra, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974); do hereby order that no person can carry raw materials/ hides/ blue wet required for running tanneries in the area falling under the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police appended to the schedule. The Officer-in-Charge of the concerned Police Station should be vigilant to check the inflows of such prohibited materials under the jurisdiction of their Police Station and if it is noticed that the inflows of such prohibited materials are still continuing despite such order, the prohibited materials are to be seized and disposed of as per norms. The Tannery Association will be the receiver of such materials under order.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.


This order shall come into force with effect from 19.06.2021 to 17.08.2021 for a period of 60 (sixty) days or until further order.

WHEREAS, with a view to protecting the city from pollution and other environmental hazards, it has been felt necessary to immediately prevent burning of waste materials, whether hazardous or non-hazardous;

AND

WHEREAS, in pursuance with the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (Act No. 29 of 1986) read with the Government of West Bengal Notification No. EN/565/3C-17/2003 dated 07.04.2005 relating to an order banning therein burning of leaves and debris in entire Kolkata area by the provision under Section 19(5) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1981, the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being the authority in whose jurisdiction any violation occurs, shall take necessary steps in accordance with the notification as per law;

Now, therefore, I, **Soumen Mitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), do hereby order that for the sake of disposal, **the act of burning of any waste, as specified in the aforesaid Acts, such as, refused derived fuel (RDF)- plastic, wood, tyre, pulp or organic waste, solid waste, residual solid waste, sanitary waste, garbage, bio mass; domestic hazardous waste - discarded paint drums, pesticide cans, CFL bulbs, tube lights, expired medicines, broken mercury thermometers, used batteries, used needles and syringes and contaminated gauge etc. generated at the household level; dry waste - waste other than bio-degradable waste, inert street sweepings, recyclable and non-recyclable waste, combustible waste and sanitary napkin and diapers etc.; non-biodegradable waste, etc., is prohibited in the area falling under the entire jurisdiction of Kolkata Police;**

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

This order shall come into force with effect from 19.06.2021 to 17.08.2021 for a period of **60 (sixty) days** or until further order;

Any person contravening this order shall be punished as per the existing law. The Officer-in-Charge of the concerned Police Station should be vigilant to prevent burning of waste materials under the jurisdiction of his Police Station;

WHEREAS, information has been received from credible sources that violent demonstrations are likely to take place resulting in large scale disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of the peace in the area as mentioned in the schedule below in the town of Kolkata (hereinafter referred to as the said areas);

AND

WHEREAS, I, **Soumen Mitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion, that there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for immediate prevention of disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of the peace within the said area as mentioned in the following schedule in the town of Kolkata ;

Now, therefore, I , **Soumen Mitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub-Section (3) of the said Section, do hereby prohibit for a period of **60 (sixty) days** from the 19.06.2021 to 17.08.2021 or until further order, **any unlawful assembly of five or more persons or taking out procession or carrying of lathi, any lethal or other dangerous weapons or doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances of the public tranquillity and breach of the peace within the said area in the town of Kolkata.**

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

Any person contravening this order shall be prosecuted under the provisions of the extant applicable laws.

The area within the jurisdiction of Hare Street Police Station in the town of Kolkata bounded -

On the North by	-	Fairlie Place and India Exchange Place ( India Exchange Place and stretch of land from N.S Road - New Koylaghata Street crossing up to N.S. Road - Fairlie Place crossing being excluded ).
On the South by	-	Shaheed Khudiram Bose Road and Rani Rashmoni Avenue (the portion of Rani Rashmoni Avenue from its crossing with Chowringhee Road upto Govt. Place East being excluded).

**EXPLANATION** : In this order, the TOWN of Kolkata means the town of Kolkata as defined in Section 3 of the Calcutta Police Act, 1866 (Bengal Act IV of 1866).

WHEREAS, a large number of commercial places/ shops have come up in Kolkata which are popularly known as Cyber Café and a large number of people visit those to use the facilities available in such places including Internet access and E-mail facility;

AND

WHEREAS, there is reasonable apprehension that Criminals / Antisocial / Antinational elements may use these facilities to mislead the security/ investigating agencies, create panic in the public, endanger the security of VVIPs and Government Institutions, help in the anti-national activities thus directly affecting the security of the State;

AND

WHEREAS, I, **SoumenMitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion that it is necessary to take speedy measures in this regard to prevent danger to human life or safety, to thwart/ prevent terrorist activities which may affect the security of the state and disturbance of public order and tranquility;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub Section (I) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub Section (3) of the said Section, I, **SoumenMitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) do hereby order: -

- a) Prohibiting the use of Cyber Café by a person whose identity has not been established by the owner of the Café.
  - b) Maintaining a register to identify the visitor/user.
  - c) Making an entry in the handwriting of the visitor/user mentioning name, address, telephone number and the details of identity proof. The visitor/user shall also sign the register kept for this purpose.
  - d) Establishing identity of the visitor/user through Identity Card issued by Govt., Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC), Ration Card, Driving License, Passport and AADHAR Card (any one of them).
  - e) Preserving activity server log in main server and its record should be preserved for at least six months.
  - f) Informing any activity of suspicious nature of a visitor by the owner of Cyber Café to the local Police Station.
- And
- g) Maintaining record about the specific computer used by the person.

The above mentioned clauses are meant for strict compliance by the owners of such Cyber Cafes in the Metropolitan area of Kolkata and its Suburbs.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C. 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation;

This order shall come into force for a period of **60 (Sixty) days** with effect from **19.06.2021 to 17.08.2021** or until further order.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under the extant applicable laws.

WHEREAS, it is reasonably apprehended that terrorist/anti-social elements in the guise of tenants/paying guests/domestic helps etc. may seek hideouts in the residential areas of the Police Stations as specified in the Schedule-I appended to this order, and there is every likelihood of breach of the peace and disturbance of public tranquility and also there is an apprehension leading to grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public property on that account;

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that some checks should be put on landlords/tenants so that terrorist/anti-social elements in the guise of tenants/paying guests/domestic helps etc. may not cause disturbance of public tranquility and damage public property etc. or hatch up any planning for the same and that immediate action is necessary to thwart any possibility of the same;

Now, therefore, I, **Soumen Mitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974); do hereby order that **no landlord/owner/person whose house property falls under the jurisdiction of area of Police Stations specified in the Schedule-I appended to this order, shall let/sublet/rent out/give licence for the use of any accommodation to any person unless and until he/she has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s)/occupier(s) etc. as the case may be, as per the proforma in Schedule-II, II(A), II(B) to the Officer-in-charge of the Police Station concerned. All persons who intend to take accommodation on rent etc. shall inform in writing in this regard to the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned in whose jurisdiction the premises fall. The persons dealing in property business shall also inform in writing to the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned in whose jurisdiction the premises fall about the particulars of the tenants/occupiers etc;**

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub-section (2) of section 144 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973. It shall be published for information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on Notice Boards of the offices of All Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

This order shall come into force on and from **19.06.2021** and shall be effective for a period of **60 (sixty)** days up to **17.08.2021** (both days inclusive) or until further order.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

**ORDER**

WHEREAS, on assessment of the law and order situation of the area as scheduled below (hereinafter referred to as 'said Area') in regard to the inputs and information received from credible sources, there are sufficient reasons of violent demonstrations/rallies/meetings by a section of public or an organization thereby causing breach of peace, disturbance of public tranquillity, health or safety, danger to human life as well as obstruction to lawfully employed persons in the said area;

AND

WHEREAS, I, Soumen Mitra, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion that there is sufficient cause to proceed under the said Section for not allowing any rallies/meetings/processions/ dharnas/ demonstrations in the following schedule in the Town of Kolkata, so as to ensure immediate prevention of breach of peace, disturbances of the public tranquillity in the said Area in view of the larger public interest;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section(1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub-Section(3) of the said Section, I, Soumen Mitra, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata police jurisdiction) do hereby prohibit for a period of **60 (Sixty) days from 19.06.2021 to 17.08.2021** or until further order, any unlawful assembly of 05(five) or more persons, carrying of lathi, any lethal or other dangerous weapons or doing of any act which is likely to cause breach of the peace and disturbances of the public tranquillity within the said Area in the town of Kolkata.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C, 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of all Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.



WHEREAS, mass petitions have been received by this office from students and scholars of several educational institutions housed in and around College Street area, requesting for not allowing any rallies, processions, meetings, demonstrations therein as the use of loudspeakers and sloganeering causes major disturbance to the ongoing classes and other academic activities;

AND

WHEREAS, I, **Soumen Mitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion that there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for not allowing any rallies/meetings/processions/demonstrations originating from/terminating in and around College Square in the academic interest of large number of students within the said areas as mentioned in the following schedule in the town of Kolkata, so as to ensure immediate prevention and speedy remedy;

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex parte under sub section 2 of section 144 of Cr.P.C, 1973. It shall be published for the information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the offices of all Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, all Police Stations concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.



**ORDER**

dated 17/06/2021

WHEREAS, it has been observed that several instances of two wheeler riders riding without helmet as well as carrying pillion riders without helmet have been reported and occurrences of such infringement of rules have increased manifold. In spite of several prosecutions in such cases being drawn up by the law enforcement agency, the apprehension and possibility of untoward incidents/ accidents arising out of riding two wheelers without helmet always remains. In order to ensure better road discipline and deter such violators of traffic laws, stringent actions need to be taken in accordance with law;

AND

WHEREAS, it is necessary that some checks should be put on such violators in the larger interest of safety of the citizens, immediate and stringent action need to be taken in accordance with law to have greater deterrence and for prevention of the same;

AND

WHEREAS, Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act. 2 of 1974) empowers an Executive Magistrate to issue order in respect of cases of apprehended danger;

Now, therefore, I, **Soumen Mitra**, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 228- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08/02/2021 read with the Notification No. 226-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05(Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 and the Notification No. 229-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 read with the Notification No. 227-P.S.Cell/H.R./O/3P-13/05 (Pt.-II) dated 08.02.2021 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974); do hereby order that a rule of **NO HELMET NO PETROL** shall be enforced within the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police to the effect that **no petrol pump within the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police shall henceforth sell petrol to any such two wheeler rider who arrives at the petrol pump riding a two wheeler without wearing helmet as well as carries pillion rider without helmet in contravention of the provisions as enumerated under sections 128, Motor Vehicles Act 1988 and 129, Motor Vehicles Act 1988 read with section 177, Motor Vehicles Act 1988.**

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub-section (2) of section 144 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973. It shall be published for information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on Notice Boards of the offices of the all Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic Department, Kolkata, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic (South), Kolkata, all the Police Stations and the Traffic Guards concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.

This order shall come into force with effect from 19.06.2021 and shall be in effect for a period of **60 (sixty) days** i.e. till 17.08.2021 or until further order.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under extant applicable laws.
